Harassment

Clothing

Rings or jewelry could be caught in equipment or become conductive and shall not be worn. No shorts, sleeveless shirts, sandals, or tennis shoes are allowed.

Drugs and Alcohol

Employees or subcontractors found to be using or in possession of any alcohol or non prescribed drugs will be removed from job site. Employees are required to notify their supervisor for any over the counter meds that may affect their ability to operate tools.

Personal Protective Equipment

Hard hats in good condition are required to be work during working hours. Safety glasses are required to be worn. Hearing protection is required when noise levels exceed 80 db. Gloves should be worn when handling equipment and materials.

Ladders

Inspect ladders before each use. Ladders are not to be used to support scaffold boards. Only one person should be on a ladder at any time. Metal ladders will not be used. Ladders with broken or missing rungs shall be removed from job site. Ladders shall be placed on a substantial base and the area around the top and bottom shall remain clear. Observe the weight limits listed on the side of the ladder.
